SUBJECT: Reorganization of 35<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division

TO: Commanding General, Fourth Army

- 1. The 35<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, now organized as a Square Division (Table of Organization 7), will be reorganized as a Triangular Division (Table of Organization 70) at the earliest practicable date, as indicated in paragraph 3.

- 4. Details of reorganization will be controlled by the Commanding General, Fourth Army, who is authorized to transfer individuals within the division as necessary, without regard to their present assignments.
- 5. Surplus equipment will be turned in to local supply agencies for redistribution as directed by the Chiefs of Arm or Service concerned.
- 6. All elements formed in the reorganization, except the 195<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery (8 inch How), and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, 132<sup>nd</sup> Engineers (Combat), will be allotted grades and ratings in accordance with paragraph 4, letter, this office, AG 221 (1-18-42) EA-A, January 21, 1942, subject, "Allotment of Grades and Ratings and Authorized Strengths to Tactical Units (less Air Corps and Service with Air Corps)." The 195<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery (8 inch How), and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, 132<sup>nd</sup> Engineers (Combat), will retain their present allotment of grades and ratings for the time being. No enlisted men will be reduced in grade or rating as a result of this reorganization. Enlisted men for whom no appropriate assignment is available will be carried as surplus in their present grades until absorbed.
- 7. Officers remaining surplus will pass to the control of the Commanding General, Fourth Army, for reassignment.
- 8. Pending the revision of Table of Organization 70-1, the retention of an Assistant Chief of Staff, G-1 in Division Headquarters is authorized.
  - 9. Non-divisional units formed in this reorganization will be attached to the First Army.
- 10. Pending the issue of 8 inch howitzers, the 195<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery (8 inch How) will be organized in accordance with Table of Organization 6-41, November 1, 1940, except that Antitank Batteries (Table of Organization 6-99, October 1, 1940) and antitank sections of the

battalion headquarters batteries (Table of Organization 6-86, October 1, 1940) will not be activated.

11. Headquarters, 132<sup>nd</sup> Engineer Regiment (Combat) is constituted on the active list.
