1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - see overlay.
- b. Defensive organization - See strong points as shown on overlay and the mine map overlay attached.
- c. Units in contact - Approximately 25 PW's captured from the 6th Co, 985th Inf Regt in location E of the river.
- d. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - no change.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - The enemy continued to defend although PW's state that the artillery and elements of the infantry opposing us began withdrawal sometime before 1200.
- b. Operations of component elements:
  - 1. Artillery - Very light artillery fire during the entire period.
  - 2. Aviation - Raid by 3 enemy aircraft (2 FW 190's and 1 ME-109) about 2250; these planes strafed and dropped bombs.  
A partly filled gas tank dropped by one of these planes fell at 493663 causing 1 casualty.
  - 3. Infantry - The infantry continued to harass our lines with mortar and machine gun fire during the period - holding the strong points. See overlay for strong points.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Total of 29 PW's captured during period. Total for operation 651.
- b. Weather - Overcast tomorrow morning with showers during the afternoon. Little change in temperature.
- c. Password - FAUCET reply LIMBER from 1200 28 July to 1200 29 July 44.


4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: No change.
