1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - see overlay.
- b. Defensive organization - The enemy defended along the line and from fortified positions shown on overlay.
- c. Units in contact - Elements of all three Bns of the 8th Para Regt have been identified on our front.
- d. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - no change.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - The enemy defended along the line shown on overlay.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Artillery - Artillery from self-propelled guns fell in the forward areas.
 2. Aviation - between 0502 and 0524 approximately 12 planes, type undetermined, came in from the SW and dropped flares in the vicinity of ST LO. After flares had been dropped, bombs and anti-personnel bombs were dropped. At 1730 2 ME-109's flew over the area toward the SW. No bombs or strafing was reported.
 3. Infantry - Enemy defended during the entire period.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Total of 10 PWs captured during period. Total for operation 780.
- b. Weather - Haze tomorrow morning with intermittent showers in the afternoon.
- c. One PW stated that the Germans habitually put Red Cross flags on supply vehicles. Information obtained from French civilian.
- d. TORIGNI is reported to be crowded with Germans both infantry and paratroops and a moderate amount of armor mounting 105's.
- e. Password - WELSH reply THANKS from 1200 31 July to 1200 1 August 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: No change.



II. Strong Points:

If there is more than one installation in one place, the following system will be used.

1. The strong point will be indicated by a black box with exact scale and firing direction of MG's and A T guns.
2. The following is a sample how to indicate all positions and weapons by using a flag:



3. Additional positions will not be added but a new flag will be made, to avoid errors.
