1. ACTIVATION OF COUNTER INTELLIGENCE CORPS DETACHMENTS. a. Pursuant to authority contained in ltr, WD, AG 322 (8 Jul 44) OB-I-GNCOT-13, 12 July 1944, subject: "Constitution and Activation of Counter Intelligence Corps Detachments," and 1st Indorsement, Headquarters European Theater of Operations, U. S. Army, 26 July 1944, the following Counter Intelligence Corps Detachments are activated as follows effective 20 August 1944 and assigned to European Theater of Operations, U. S. Army:

b. Personnel. (1) Officer and enlisted personnel of the Counter Intelligence Corps Detachment Numbers 1 and 2 (Prov), 213th CIC Det (Prov) and 309th CIC Det (Prov) will be transferred by the commanders concerned to the corresponding newly activated units on date of activation. (2) Additional personnel necessary to bring units to authorized strength will be requisitioned in the normal manner. (3) By authority of TTR, Headquarters European Theater of Operations, U.S. Army, dated 1 August 1944, effective on date of activation, enlisted personnel of these detachments may be promoted within Table of Organization limitations by Commanding General of unit to which attached. Recommendations for promotions of officer personnel will be processed in the same manner as those of units to which detachments are attached. (4) Personnel of these detachments will be classified as Branch Immateral; they are authorized to wear the insignia of any unit to which the detachment may be attached, or such other insignia as may be required to accomplish a special mission.

c. Equipment. (1) The equipment of provisional CIC detachments now attached to Headquarters Ninth U. S. Army, XIII Corps, 82d Airborne Division, and 101st Airborne Division, will be transferred by the commanders concerned to the newly activated units. (2) Table of Organization and Equipment 30-500, 24 January 1944, with changes 1, governs the issue of organizational equipment. (3) Table of equipment 21, 15 December 1943, governs the issue of clothing and individual equipment not provided for in other tables. (4) The newly activated units will be in the same priorities for controlled equipment as the headquarters companies of the units to which they are attached. (5) Requisitions for shortages of non-controlled items,

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except Chemical Warfare Service, will be submitted to the depots normally supplying the unit. Requisitions for controlled items, except Chemical Warfare Service, will be forwarded through this headquarters to the Chief of Supply Services, Headquarters European Theater of Operations, U. S. Army, APO 871, U. S. Army.

(6) All Chemical Warfare Service items will be requisitioned from the Chemical Warfare Office, this headquarters.

d. Obligate funds under appropriate allotments published in Section "I, Circular 246, WD, 1944, to the extent necessary.
