By direction of the President, under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, and under authority contained in Circular No 32, Headquarters European Theater of Operations, United States Army, 20 March 1944, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded to:

Colonel Hartwin A. Schulze, 021474, (then Lieutenant Colonel), Medical Corps, Headquarters Ninth United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 16 November 1944 to 15 April 1945. Entered military service from New York.

Lieutenant Colonel Lucius N. Cron, 018411, Coast Artillery Corps, 55th Antiaircraft Artillery Brigade, United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 26 March 1945 to 5 April 1945. Entered military service from Washington, D.C.

Lieutenant Colonel George W. Fisher, 0248561, Corps of Engineers, 1677th Engineer Survey Liaison Team, United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 October 1944 to 15 April 1945. Entered military service from Maryland.
