By direction of the President, under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, and under authority contained in Circular No 32, Headquarters European Theater of Operations, United States Army, 20 March 1944, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded to:

Captain Jack A. Pitt, O442489, Corps of Engineers, 187th Engineer Combat Battalion, United States Army, for meritorious achievement in connection with military operations from 10 March 1945 to 25 March 1945. Entered military service from Missouri.

First Lieutenant Herman E. Greer, O1179870, Field Artillery, 265th Field Artillery Battalion, United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 September 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Mississippi.

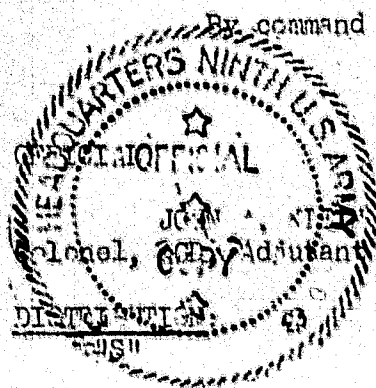
