AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL. By direction of the President, under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, and under authority contained in Circular No 32, Headquarters European Theater of Operations, United States Army, 20 March 1945, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded to:

Lieutenant Colonel Lewis G. Apps, 0283735, (then Major), Infantry, Headquarters Ninth United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 3 September 1944 to 31 December 1944. Entered military service from Pennsylvania.

Lieutenant Colonel Melvin F. Eyerman, 021026, Medical Corps, 91st Medical Gas Treatment Battalion, United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 August 1944 to 2 April 1945. Entered military service from Ohio.

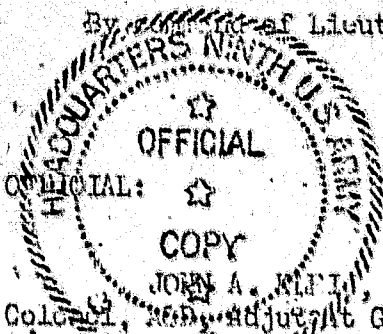
