AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL. By direction of the President, under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, and under authority contained in Circular No 32, Headquarters European Theater of Operations, United States Army, 20 March 1944, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded to:

✓ Lieutenant Colonel Charles H. Stephens, 0254552, (then Major and Lieutenant Colonel), Air Corps, Headquarters Ninth United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 27 August 1944 to 15 January 1945. Entered military service from Ohio.

✓ Major Clair F. Bowman, 0245952, Corps of Engineers, Headquarters Ninth United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 February 1945 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Nebraska.

✓ Major George T. Carey, Jr., 0293701, Infantry, Headquarters Ninth United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 March 1945 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from North Carolina.

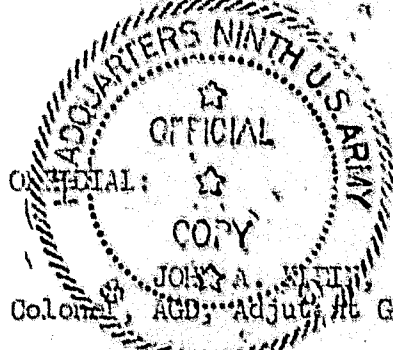
