II. AMENDMENT OF GENERAL ORDERS.

I. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL. By direction of the President, under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, and under authority contained in Circular No 32, Headquarters European Theater of Operations, United States Army, 20 March 1944, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded to:

Colonel Charles O. Grace, 09476, Veterinary Corps, Headquarters Ninth United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 23 February 1945 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from New York.

Lieutenant Colonel Arthur E. Tonney, 0385608, (then Major and Lieutenant Colonel), Ordnance Department, 60th Ordnance Group, United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 2 October 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from New York.

Major Lemuel T. Holley, Jr., 0414180, (then Captain and Major), Ordnance Department, 60th Ordnance Group, United States Army, for meritorious achievement in connection with military operations from 2 October 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Georgia.

Major Harley M. Riley, 0361093, Sanitary Corps, Headquarters Ninth United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 October 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from New York.

Major Paul A. Rutherford, 0289292, Signal Corps, Headquarters Ninth United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 5 September 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Ohio.

Major Jacob P. Wegmuller, 0275795, Ordnance Department, 260th Ordnance Battalion, United States Army, for meritorious achievement in connection with military operations from 7 February 1945 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Iowa.

Captain Frank L. Sherem, 0485243, Ordnance Department, 60th Ordnance Group, United States Army, for meritorious achievement in connection with military operations from 2 October 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Georgia.

Master Sergeant Keith O. Bigler, 20304351, Coast Artillery Corps, Headquarters Detachment, Ninth United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 5 September 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Pennsylvania.

Technical Sergeant James R. Sanucci, 39154730, (then Staff Sergeant), Coast Artillery Corps, Headquarters Detachment, Ninth United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 5 September 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from California.
