AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL. By direction of the President, under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, and under authority contained in T-7, Headquarters Army Ground Forces, 22 September 1945, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded to:

Lieutenant Colonel William R. Kirchner, O-287775, (then Major), Infantry, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 December 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Illinois.

Major Robert J. Dodds, O-1284679, Infantry, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 6 January 1945 to 16 April 1945. Entered military service from Pennsylvania.

Major Le Roy G. Holm, O-454268, (then Captain and Major), Inspector General's Department, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 December 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Wisconsin.

Captain Ralph F. Lounsberry, O-1037135, (then First Lieutenant and Captain), Chemical Warfare Service, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 November 1944 to 1 May 1945. Entered military service from Pennsylvania.

Captain James L. McCain, O-1281472, Finance Department, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 28 June 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Washington D. C.

Captain Leo A. Pokerr, O-493383, Medical Corps, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 19 September 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Ohio.

Captain George L. Tsoulas, O-1003056, Quartermaster Corps, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 February 1945 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Maine.

First Lieutenant Herman G. Kreinberg, O-2007888, (then Master Sergeant and Second Lieutenant), AUS, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 15 October 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Ohio.

Warrant Officer Junior Grade Clemens J. Wiese, W-2132824, (then Technical Sergeant), USA, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 5 September 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from California.

Master Sergeant Armin G. Klug, 36047734, Finance Department, Headquarters Detachment Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 5 September 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Illinois.
