AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL. By direction of the President, under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 September 1945, as amended, and under authority contained in T.O., Headquarters Army Ground Force, 22 September 1945, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded to:

Lieutenant Colonel Iathrop R. Read, Jr., O-243340, (then Major and Lieutenant Colonel), Corps of Military Police, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 January 1945 to 1 April 1945. Entered military service from Kansas.

Captain William F. Kubicek, O-414930, Medical Corps, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 5 September 1944 to 1 April 1945. Entered military service from Ohio.

Captain John J. Shultz, O-25550, Coast Artillery Corps, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 October 1944 to 31 December 1944. Entered military service from Pennsylvania.

Captain John Harrison Stewart, O-1642613, (then First Lieutenant and Captain), Signal Corps, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 November 1944 to 6 May 1945. Entered military service from New Jersey.

First Lieutenant Ernest Joseph Lovanyak, O-1648550, (then Second Lieutenant), Signal Corps, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 5 September 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from New Jersey.

Chief Warrant Officer Robert A. Rullard, W-2113455, USA, Headquarters Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 1 October 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Alabama.

Staff Sergeant Walter P. Plomondon, 11053954, (then Technician Third Grade and Staff Sergeant), Ordnance Department, Headquarters Detachment, Ninth Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations from 28 August 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered military service from Massachusetts.

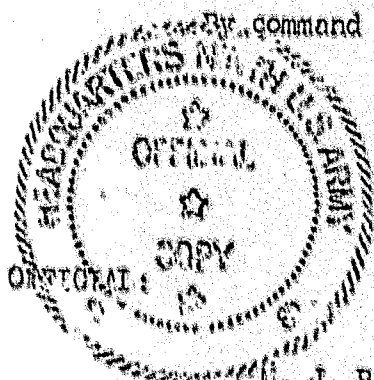
