... AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL. By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Sec I, Cir 52, HQ ETO US Army, 20 March 1944, as amended by Sec I, Cir 50, HQ ETO US Army, 27 May 1944, a Bronze Star Medal is awarded for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States during the respective periods indicated, to:

Major SAMUEL T HILL, 0145356, Adjutant General Department, Headquarters, Third United States Army. 24 March 1944 to 8 May 1945 in the UNITED KINGDOM, FRANCE, BELGIUM, LUXEMBOURG, GERMANY, AUSTRIA, and CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

First Lieutenant FRANK D SMITH, 01035202, Chemical Warfare Service, Company C, 95th Chemical Mortar Battalion, United States Army. 4 April 1945 to 7 May 1945 in GERMANY.

Staff Sergeant OWEN S HOFFLER, 33040833, Company A, 95th Chemical Mortar Battalion, United States Army. 5 April 1945 to 7 May 1945 in GERMANY.

Sergeant WILLIAM CICHOWICZ, 32110852, Company B, 95th Chemical Mortar Battalion, United States Army. 4 April 1945 to 3 May 1945 in GERMANY.

Corporal HENRY CHEAFSKY, 33576738, Company B, 95th Chemical Mortar Battalion, United States Army. 4 April 1945 to 5 May 1945 in GERMANY.

Corporal NORMAN A EDNIE, 36037920, Company B, 95th Chemical Mortar Battalion, United States Army. 27 April 1945 to 28 April 1945 in GERMANY.




