I. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL (OAK-LEAF CLUSTER) - By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Sec I, Cir 32, Hq ETO US Army, 20 Mar 1944, as amended by Sec I, Cir 56, Hq ETO US Army, 27 May 1944, in addition to the Bronze Star Medal previously awarded, a Bronze Oak-Leaf Cluster is awarded to:

Colonel CHARLES B ODON, O180718, Medical Corps, Headquarters Third United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in FRANCE, LUXEMBOURG, BELGIUM and GERMANY from 1 August 1944 to 15 February 1945.

II. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL - By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Sec I, Cir 32, Hq ETO US Army, 20 Mar 1944, as amended by Sec I, Cir 56, Hq ETO US Army, 27 May 1944, a Bronze Star Medal is awarded for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States during the respective periods indicated, to:

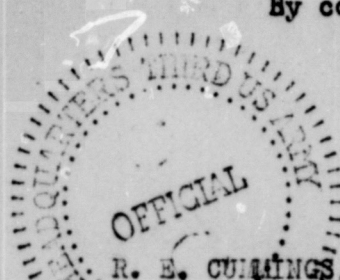

Sergeant ANTHONY KIERNAN, 32105657, Headquarters Company, Third United States Army. 20 July 1944 to 15 April 1945 in FRANCE, LUXEMBOURG and GERMANY.

Private First Class JOSEPH R LANGFORD, 18049742, Headquarters Battery, 220th Field Artillery Group, United States Army. On 2 May 1945 in GERMANY.
