AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL

1. By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Sec I, Cir 32, Hq ETO US Army, 20 Mar 44, as amended by Sec I, Cir 56, Hq ETO US Army, 27 May 44, the award of the Bronze Star Medal to the following named officer on 3 June 1945 is announced:

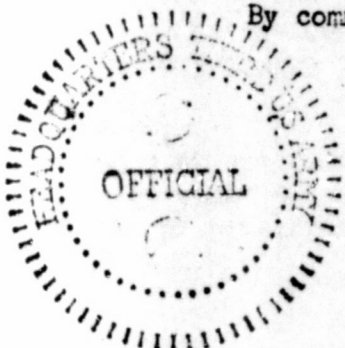
