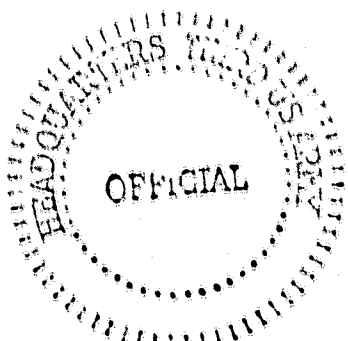
I. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL. By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Section I, Circular 32, Headquarters, European Theater of Operations, United States Army, 20 March 1944, as amended by Section I, Circular 56, Headquarters, European Theater of Operations, United States Army, 27 May 1944, a Bronze Star Medal is awarded for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States during the respective periods indicated, to:

Captain JOHN D VAN DER TOOREN, 103038, Army of the Netherlands, Military Government Detachment F1H2, Company H, 2d European Civil Affairs Regiment, United States Army. 23 April 1945 to 26 May 1945 in GERMANY.

II. AWARD OF PURPLE HEART MEDAL. By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, as amended, the Purple Heart Medal is awarded to:

Corporal GROVER C HOFF, 36740981, Headquarters Detachment, Third United States Army. For wounds received as a direct result of enemy action on 25 April 1945 in GERMANY.
