I. ANNOUNCEMENT OF ACTING ENGINEER OFFICER - Colonel DONALD A BULLIGT, 019719, Corps of Engineers, this Headquarters, is announced as Acting Engineer Officer Headquarters Third United States Army.

II. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL - By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Sec I, Cir 32, Hq ETO US Army, 20 March 1944, as amended by Sec I, Cir 56, Hq ETO US Army, 27 May 1944, a Bronze Star Medal is awarded for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States during the respective periods indicated, to:

Major HARRY T GILBERT JR, 0324211, Field Artillery, Headquarters 938th Field Artillery Battalion, United States Army. 1 June 1944 to 8 May 1945 in the UNITED KINGDOM, FRANCE, LUXEMBOURG, BELGIUM, GERMANY, AUSTRIA and CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

Major JOHN J HAMLIN, 01573254, Adjutant General's Department, Headquarters Third United States Army. 1 August 1944 to 8 May 1945 in FRANCE, LUXEMBOURG and GERMANY.

III. AMENDMENT OF GENERAL ORDERS NUMBER 224, THIS HEADQUARTERS, CS - So much of Section II, General Orders Number 224, this Headquarters, cs, awarding the Bronze Star Medal to Major LETHUEL G DUKE JR, 0384060, Field Artillery as reads: "a Bronze Star Medal is awarded for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States during the respective periods indicated, to:" is amended to read: "in addition to the Bronze Star Medal previously awarded, a Bronze Oak-Leaf Cluster is awarded for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States during the respective periods indicated, to:"

REVOCATION OF GENERAL ORDERS NUMBER 226, THIS HEADQUARTERS, CS - So much of Paragraph 2., Section III, General Orders Number 226, this Headquarters, cs, as awards a Bronze Star Medal to Lieutenant Colonel EDWARD E SCOVILL, 0338674, Coast Artillery Corps, Headquarters 44th Antiaircraft Artillery Brigade, United States Army is revoked.

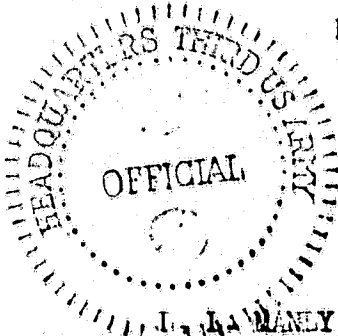
