ATARD OF DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS (FOSTHUMOUS)

. By Direction of the Fresident and under the provisions of Sec I, Cir 32, Hq ETO US Army, 20 March 1944, as amended by Sec I, Cir 56, Hq ETO US Army, 27 May 1944, a Distinguished Service Cross is awarded posthumously to:

Captain FATRICK TMERRY, 01291679, Infantry, Company C, 331st Infantry Regiment, 83d Infantry Division, United States Army. For estraordinary heroism in connection with military operations avainst an armed enemy in CERTANI. On 14 April 1945, near Walternerman, 3-Tauny, Septemin MERRY forced the surrender of two enemy snipers in a formale with accurate rifle fire. Then his company was pinned down by a victous crossfire from snipers and machine gans, this intrepid officer mounted a tank, marmed a machine fun and directed the tank towards the first enemy strongpoint. Although mortally wounded, he continued to direct his company until they had cleared the enemy strongpoint and captured a large number of prisoners. Captain MERRY's heroic, inspiring leadership and supreme devotion to duty are in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service.

Corporal OR'ALD IRVIN, 37399188, Company H. A'Oth Infantry Regiment, 102d Infantry Division, United States Army. For extraordinary barolem in connection with militar operations against an armod enemy in Carlandy. On 10 april 1945, near RIVI of the articling element of his unit was pirmed down by withering he small arms and machine gun fire, Corporal INVIN courageously volunteered at appt to silance the enemy machine fare, armed with granades and a carbine he fearlessly advanced through the intense fire to a point within granades throwing distance of the hostile emplacement. Although his first granade killed the enemy soldier manning the machine gun, Corporal IRVIN are mortally wounded while attempting to silance other enemy positions. The intropid gallantry and supreme devotion to duty displayed by Corporal IRVIN all live on as an inspiration to the near of the armed forces.

Private First Class Ralph H "IGRY, 19203)"2, Company I, 319th Infantry Regiment, 80th Infantry Division, United States from. For extraordinary heroism in connection with military operations against an 'raid onery in Garland. On 13 February 1945, during an attack on Siegfried Line positions near 'MILLELEEF, GERLENY, Private HIGBY led a squad of three man which captured an enemy-held rallbox. When his squad was subjected to a finned enemy occusteration, this intropid soldier, with druntless courage, advancing alone towards the enemy, fixed his BAR with such devastating effect that they were forced to wat draw. Later Private HIGBY was found face to the enemy, mortally wounded, with his finger still on the trigger of his BAR. His indemitable fighting spirit and supreme devotion to duty will live in as an inspiration to the new with when he fought.

Private First Class LECKARD F KTAUSE, 36056686, Company L, AO6th Infantry Regiment, 102d Infantry Division, United States Army. For extraordinary heroism in connection with military operations against an armed enemy in G RYMMY. On 10 April 1945, near LUHDEN, GERMANY, Frivate FRAUSE'S plateon was advancing over open

ground up a hill when they were pinned down by withering hostile small arms, automatic weapons and machine gun fire emanating from cleverly concealed positions at the creat of the hill. With utter disregard for his own life he gallantly moved to the flank, rose to his feet in the face of the murderous enemy fire and placed such devastating BAR fire upon the enemy that both his squad and another plateon were enabled to withdraw without casualties. Private KRAUSE was killed by a sniper before he could again drop to the ground but his self-sacrificing hereism and supreme devotion to du. will live on as an inspiration to the men with whom he fought.
