I. AMARD OF DISTINGUISTED SHEWICE CROSS .. By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Suc I, the 33, Eq ETO US Army, 20 March 1944, as amended by Suc I, Cir 56, Eq ETO US Army, 27 Tay 1744, a Distinguished Service Cross is awarded to:

staff Sergenn's EICHIED M CRCFF, 33149278, Company L, 328th Infantry Regiment, 26th Infantry Division, United States army. For extraordinary hereism in connection with military operations against an armed enemy in LUIR BOURG. On 3 January 1945, during fibres action non NOTHAL, LUXGIRGURG, Sergeant GROFF, exposing himself to intense hostile tank fire, picked up a light machine gun and a box of ammunition and led two machine gun sections into position. Then the crews of the other two guns were killed by enemy sniper fire, this intrepid soldier dropped to his knees and oroned fire with his machine gun. His ammunition exhausted, he crawled through the withoring hostile fire to man one of the other machine gund, noutralizing the enemy fire and enabling his plateon to move into a more favorable position. Surgeant GROFF'S heroic, dauntless actions and unflinching devotion to duty are in keeping with the finest traditions of the military service.

Private First Class HANRY C Califfle JR, 33501093, Headquarters Company, 104th Infantry Regiment, 26th Infantry Division, United States army. For extraordinary horoism in connection with military operations against on armud enemy in FRANCE. On 22 October 1944, during action near l'ONCOUNT WOODS, PRANCE, Private GAMBLEIS company was pinned down by intense enemy muchine run fire. With utter disregard for his own safet, he volunteered to silence the waren and fearlessly advanced alone, armed only with a demolition charge. Skilfully maneuvering to within a few feut of the enemy emplacement, he lit the charge and thravit into the machine gum position, destroying the gun and killing the cory of six. Private GaMBLE'S hereic, dauntless notions and unflinching devetion to duty are in keeping with the highest traditions of the military rervice.


