SECTION I - Unit Citation SECTION II - Award of Bronze Star Modal

I. UNIT CITATION - Under the provisions of Section IV, Circular 333, War Departmont, 22 Docomber 1943, Battery "A", 482d Antiaircraft Artillory Automatic Weapons Battalion (SP) is cited for its actions during the period 17 December -26 December 1914. During this poriod Rattery "A" was assigned the mission of furnishing ground support to infantry, or livry, and tank destroyer units defonding positions against the strong enemy thrust into Belgium and Luxembourg. Facing overwhelming odds with outstanding heroism the Battery fought stubbornly over difficult terrain, inflicting heavy losses upon the enemy. At one time this unit held a sector alone, without the immediate support of other arms. The indomitable fighting spirit; the courage and devotion to duty of the officers and men of this Battery are in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service.

Private First Class RALPH E LAWHORN, 33655040, Company "C", 92d Medical Gas Troubment Battalion, United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in FRANCE from 20 November 1944 to 25 January 1945.
