First Lieutenant MARY K BURKLE MART, M751382, Army Nurse Corps, 109th Evacuation Hospital, United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in the UNITED KINGDOM and FRANCE from 1 June 1944 to 25 January 1945.


