AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL

By direction of the President and under the provisions of Section I, Circular Number 32, Headquarters, European Theater of Operations, United States Army, dated 20 March 1944, as amended by Section I, Circular Number 56, Headquarters, European Theater of Operations, United States Army, dated 27 May 1944, a Bronze Star Medal is awarded to:

Captain EUNICE V. MCALIFFE, Q1320064, Infantry, Provost Marshal Section, Headquarters Third United States Army, United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in FRANCE, LUXEMBOURG, and GERMANY. During the period 27 August 1944 to 8 May 1945, Captain McAULIFFE, serving as Assistant Maintenance of Law and Order Officer in the Provost Marshal Section, Headquarters Third United States Army, distinguished himself by his outstanding performance of duty. The sizable task of controlling general prisoners, stragglers, and absences, and investigating serious crimes, which he accomplished during combat operations, when communications were often uncertain and command difficult to exercise, was a considerable factor in assisting in the maintenance of law, order and discipline. His sound judgment, exemplary conduct and loyal devotion to duty reflect great credit upon himself and the military service.
