AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL

By direction of the President and under the provisions of Sec 1, Cir 32, Hq BT, US Army, 20 Mar 1944, as amended by Sec 1, Cir 56, Hq BT, US Army, 27 May 1944, a Bronze Star Medal is awarded to:

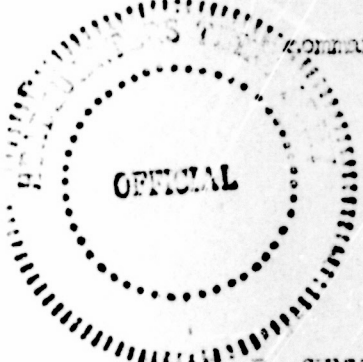
