Staff Sergeant THEODORE A. CEGIELSKI, 36238282, 39th Evacuation Hospital, United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in FRANCE from 17 July 1944 to 28 February 1945.

Technician Fourth Grade GEORGE C. ARONIS, 31356811, 107th Evacuation Hospital, United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in FRANCE from 18 July 1944 to 20 March 1945.

Technician Fourth Grade ROY W. BATTIEGER, 35730117, 1st Platoon, 42d Field Hospital, United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in LUXEMBOURG from 13 February 1945 to 25 March 1945.

Technician Fifth Grade WILLIS ECKLEY JR, 33760442, Battery B, 773d Field Artillery Battalion, United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in FRANCE and GERMANY from 1 September 1944 to 15 January 1945.

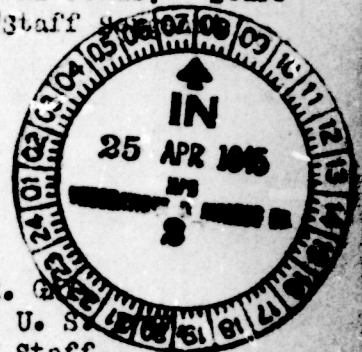
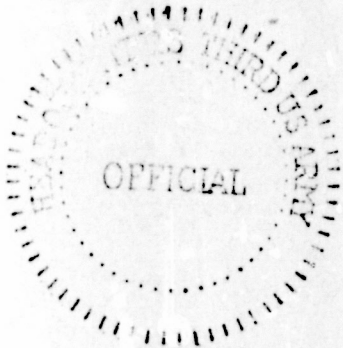
