✓ First Lieutenant ROBERT H PALMATARY, 01558312, Ordnance Department, 88th Bomb Disposal Squad, United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States at NANCY, FRANCE from 16 September 1944 to 6 October 1944.

✓ Lieutenant Colonel HERBERT W MEYER, 0467526, Medical Corps, 12th Evacuation Hospital, United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in the UNITED KINGDOM and FRANCE from 1 April 1944 to 21 December 1944.

✓ Lieutenant Colonel AUGUST C PAVLATOS, 0358275, Medical Corps, 101st Evacuation Hospital, United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in FRANCE from 15 July 1944 to 15 December 1944.

✓ Captain RUTH J OLSON, N767273, Army Nurse Corps, 101st Evacuation Hospital, United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in FRANCE from 12 July 1944 to 15 December 1944.

✓ First Lieutenant BOISE F MACON, 0526757, Coast Artillery Corps, Photo Interpretation Team No. 49, United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in the UNITED KINGDOM and FRANCE from 1 June 1944 to 15 November 1944.

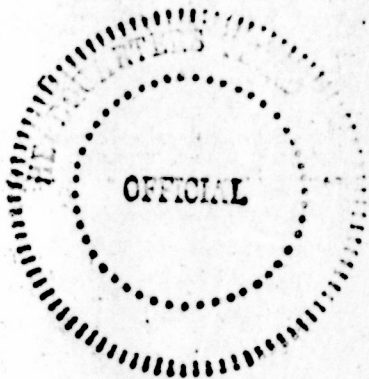
