I. BRONZE STAR MEDAL. - By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Sec I, Cir 52, Hq BTO US Army, 20 March 1944, as amended by Sec I, Cir 56, Hq BTO US Army, 27 May 1944, a Bronze Star Medal is awarded for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States during the respective periods indicated, to:

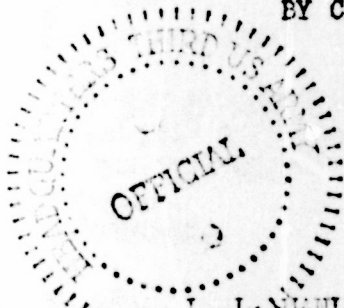
Technician Third Grade PIERRE WINO MOLINARO, 32931205, Headquarters Third United States Army. 1 August 1944 to 8 May 1945 in FRANCE, LUXEMBOURG and GERMANY.

~~II. DISCONTINUANCE. - Effective 5 November 1945, Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, Signal Intelligence Battalion, Third United States Army (Provisional) is discontinued at WEISBACH GERMANY (U-3544). (Authority: AR 220-5, 16 December 1944).~~

~~III. ORGANIZATION. - Effective 1 November 1945, the organization of the Special Historical Projects Detachment, Third United States Army (Provisional) with initial station at REGENSBURG GERMANY (U-1865), is announced. (Authority: AR 220-5, 16 December 1944).~~

~~IV. AMENDMENT OF GENERAL ORDERS NUMBER 303, THIS HEADQUARTERS, CS. - So much of Section II, General Order No. 303, Headquarters as announcing Colonel ROBERT C TRIPP as Transportation Officer, Third United States Army as roads, "Quartermaster Corps" is amended to read: "Transportation Corps."~~
