I. BRONZE STAR MEDAL. - By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Soc I, Cir 32, HQ ETO US Army, 20 March 1944, as amended by Soc I, Cir 56, HQ ETO US Army, 27 May 1944, a bronze star Medal is awarded for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States during the respective periods indicated, to:

Technician Third Grade FIDELINO MOLINARO, 32901285, Headquarters Third United States Army. 1 August 1944 to 8 May 1945 in FRANCE, LUXEMBOURG and GERMANY.

II. DISCONTINUANCE. - Effective 5 November 1945, Headquarters ~~and Headquarters~~ Detachments, Signal Intelligence Battalion, Third United States Army (Provisional) is discontinued at REISBACH GERMANY (U-3547). (Authority: AR 220-5, 16 December 1944).

III. ORGANIZATION. - Effective 1 November 1945, the organization of the Special Historical Projects Detachment, Third United States Army (Provisional) with initial station at RENGERSBURG GERMANY (U-1865), is announced. (Authority: AR 220-5, 16 December 1944).

IV. AMENDMENT OF GENERAL ORDERS NUMBER 303. THIS ~~HEADQUARTERS~~ is so much of Section II, General Order No. 303, Headquarters as announcing Colonel ROBERT C TRIPP as Transportation Officer, Third United States Army, as reads; "Quartermaster Corps" is amended to read: "Transportation Corps."
