For heroic achievement in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in FRINCE. On 6 November 1944, when Private First Class SHIROYAMA'S depleted company was halted by a withering hail of enemy machine gum fire during an attack near LEPANGES, FRINCE, he fearlessly crawled forward through a belt of anti-personnel mines and with deadly fire killed the gumner and forced the remainder of the hostile crew to abandon the position. Later, when his comrades were ordered to take up more tenable positions, he courageously remained behind under heavy enemy shell-fire to cover their withdrawal. Private First Class SHIROYAMA'S dauntless actions and unswerving devotion to duty reflect great credit upon himself and the military service.
