I. AWARD OF SILVER STAR. By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Sec I, Cir 32, Hq ETO US Army, 20 March 1944, as amended by Sec I, Cir 56, Hq ETO US Army, 27 May 1944, a Silver Star is awarded to:

Technical Sergeant ADO F LANGENKAMP, 35665796, Company F, 329th Infantry Regiment, 83d Infantry Division, United States Army. For gallantry in action in FRANCE. On 10 August 1944, Technical Sergeant LANGENKAMP led his platoon in a spirited assault against fortified enemy positions southeast of ST. MALO FRANCE. Although under constant enemy observation and himself the target of withering hostile fire, he advanced alone and cleared a path through an enemy mine field for his platoon. When a hostile machine gun opened fire at him as he advanced, he tossed a hand grenade into the position, killing the gunner and forcing the remainder of the crew to surrender. Inspired by his personal example of heroism, his comrades continued the assault, attaining their objective and inflicting heavy casualties in men and materiel upon the enemy. Technical Sergeant LANGENKAMP'S courageous leadership and outstanding devotion to duty reflect great credit upon himself and the military service.

II. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL. By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Sec I, Cir 32, Hq ETO US Army, 20 March 1944, as amended by Sec I, Cir 56, Hq ETO US Army, 27 May 1944, a Bronze Star Medal is awarded for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States during the respective periods indicated, to:

First Lieutenant WILLIAM B LINEWEAVER, 02028848, Signal Corps, Headquarters Third United States Army. 1 January 1945 to 8 May 1945 in GERMANY.

First Sergeant REUBEN L BARTLELL, 16068133, 295th Quartermaster Salvage Repair Company, United States Army. 4 October 1944 to 8 May 1945 in GERMANY.

Staff Sergeant ROBERT K GERDES, 37419765, 295th Quartermaster Salvage Repair Company, United States Army. 4 October 1944 to 8 May 1945 in GERMANY.

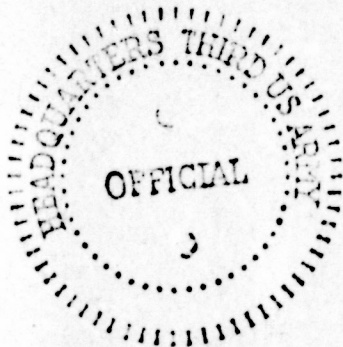
