By Direction of the President and under the provisions of sec I, Cir 32, Eq ETO US Army, 20 March 19th, as anonded by Sec I, Cir 56, Hq ETO US Army, 27 May 19th, a Silver Star is awarded to: Tochrical Sergeant ADO F LANGENNA P. 35665796, Company F, 329th Infantry Regiment, 83d Infantry Division, United States Army. For gallantry in action in FRANCE. on 10 August 1914, Tochmical Sorgeant LANGENKAMP led his platoon in a spirited assault against fortified enemy positions southeast of ST. MALO FRANCE. Although under constant enony observation and himself the target of withering hostile fire, he advanced alone and cleared a path through an enemy mine field for his platoen. When a hestile machine gun opened fire at him as he advanced, he tossed a hand grenade into the position, killing the gunner and forcing the remainder of the crow to surrender. Inspired by his personal example of heroism, his comrades continued the assault, attaining their objective and inflicting heavy casulties in men and materiel upon the enemy. Technical Sergoant LANGENKAMP'S courageous leadership and outstanding devotion to duty reflect great credit upon himself and the military service. II. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL.
