SECTION II - Amendment to General Orders Number 322, this Headquarters, cs.

I. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL. By Direction of the President and under the provisions of Sec I, Cir 32, Hq ETO US Army, 20 March 1944, as amended by Sec I, Cir 56, Hq ETO US Army, 27 May 1944, a Bronze Star Medal is awarded for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States during the respective periods indicated, to:

Major JAMES N FUQUAY, 01103170, Transportation Corps, Headquarters, Third United States Army. 17 September 1944 to 8 May 1945 in FRANCE and GERMANY.

Captain CLAUDE P MERRY, 55531, Army of France. 27 March 1945 to 8 May 1945 in GERMANY.

Captain ALFRED W PETERSON, Army of the United States, Military Government Detachment I-339, Company A, 3rd Military Government Regiment, United States Army. 30 April 1945 to 8 May 1945 in GERMANY.

First Lieutenant DAVID L BROWN, 0524369, Infantry, Headquarters Company, Third United States Army. 7 December 1944 to 7 May 1945 in FRANCE, LUXEMBOURG and GERMANY. *Award revoked by 30 342 - 16 Dec 45*

Sergeant (then Corporal) ERNEST HORMANN, 42051072, Detachment I-336, Company A, 3rd Military Government Regiment, United States Army. 12 August 1944 to 8 May 1945 in FRANCE and GERMANY.

Technician Fifth Grade RICHARD V ALDRIDGE, 32957859, 86th Quartermaster Car Platoon, United States Army. 15 September 1944 to 8 May 1945 in FRANCE and GERMANY.

II. AMENDMENT TO GENERAL ORDERS NUMBER 332, THIS HEADQUARTERS, CS. 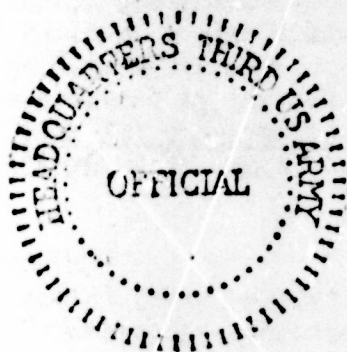
