AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL

1. By direction of the President and under the provisions of Sec I, Cir 32, Hq ETO US Army, 20 Mar 1944, as amended by Sec I, Cir 56, Hq ETO US Army, 27 May 1944, the award of the Bronze Star Medal to each of the following named officers on 11 October 1944 is announced:

Brigadier General HOBART R GAY, 07323, United States Army, Headquarters Third United States Army. For meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in France from 1 August 1944 to 11 October 1944.

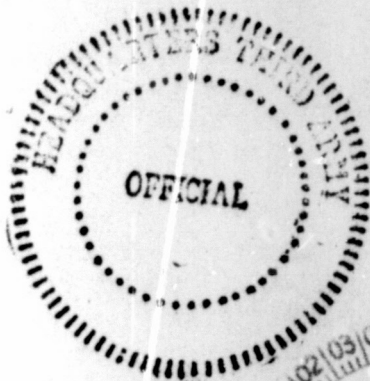
