The enemy is in position of the S and SE pertien of Fresms. Our strength is in the northern part. The Bn will eccupy Hill 318 prepared to attack and surprise the enemy by breaking out of the woods and retaking Fresnes. Attack upon division order. Division Arty will support this attack by coordinated fire on the southern part of Fresnes and Hill 282, S of Fresnes AT Co protects talegraphizations line Telegraph Hill - Fresnes. This Co will be attached to the 2nd Bn, 1126th, for the attack.

## PW REPORT

PW from 4th Co of unknown regiment -- not an SS unit. Attempts to identify unit by APO number 64951E and by name of Commanding General were fruitless.

PW deserted from his unit by crossing the remains of the bridge at SARREINSMING. He was able to cross this bridge without getting wet by balancing himself on the debris. PW's unit came into position two days ago after having been in position in SAAREGUEMINES on the west side of the SAAR R. They withdrew to the east bank without having been in battle. The strength of the unit which withdrew across the river was about 80 men and included one patoon of the 4th Co and the 1st Co.

PW disclosed the following positions:

- 1 120mm mortar at 555551

Arty Position (probably one pece) at old rifle range in woods at 555558. Plat CP in hut at 552556.

PW's unit has had 2 casualties he knows of in last two days. He has heard that there are some SS troops in the vic but has not seen any. In SARREINSMING, he saw one sentry about 20 yds east of end of bridge. He believes there are tropps in this town, but saw no others and does not believe that there are many in the town.

PW did not habitually carry gas mask nor did others in his unit. He has the same mask he was issued in 1941; was issued a new filter

in 1943. He seem no indication of the use of gas.

## TACTICAL INTERROGATION HE FORT IPW TEAM 60-B, 134TH INFANTRY

Supply Corrany, fighting as infantry, occupied Vaxy. Beginning yesterday afternoon they commenced to withdraw in the direction of Morhange using the highway which runs along the SE edge of the Forest de Chateau-Salins. There were other troops in this town as well, and five tractor-towed 75mm AT guns. One of those was destroyed. The PW say that by last night the town was empty.

The men from the Supply Company are all over 40 years of age and say they were picked for line duty because of political non-conformance.

The Fortresss MG Bn also consists of eld men. It is part of the fixed defense of the West Wall and the battalion is spread out between here and Metz. They have beer in contact with the 80th Div for some time.

It is the opinion of the PW that the old men are being used to cover the withdrawel of the better, younger soldiers (e.g. 11th Armd Div) to the old German frontier.

TW located dummy mines in vicinity of Achain. These consist of wooden stakes connected with wires. PW states that they are not explosive.

FW also saw 50 or 60 tanks in this vicinity on 9 Nov. FW also saw a battery of 105 and one of 150 mm in a clearing near the NE edge of the C S forest.

The horses of the supply company are in Racrange: there are about 60 horses.
