TACTICAL INTERROGATION REPORT IPW THAM 60-B, 134TH INFANTRY

8 Nov 44

6 PW from the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Cos, 1127th Regt.

Captured by the 320th and the 137th.

PW state that the 3rd Co is located north and northeast of AMELECOURT. There is some barbed wire around their position but no mines. The town of Amelecourt itself is unoccupied.

One PW states there are some anti-to nk mines in the draw C63263.

The artillery barrage this morning did not fire into the position these men occupied, having fallen farther to the rear. They were impressed by it, however.

In all companies PWs report a few colds, but nothing approaching a influenza epidemic.

No PV know anything about what is in the Chateau-Salins forest, except that the 1st Bn CP is somewhere in there. PW had been in line for three weeks since they arrived as replacements from Hanau near Frankfurt.. Since that time they have not left their emplacements except for meals.

Mission of PW's unit was to hold the line. They issued no order to retreat.

Strength of 3rd Co is about 80 men.

A PW from the 1st Co, who was captured on an outpost, states that his company is located along the RR line between the 2nd and the 3rd Cos. The strength is 60-80 men.
