INTERROGATION REPORT

134TH INF REGT

IHW 60

28 Dec 44

2 PW from 8th Co, 15th Frcht Regt.

PW were captured in a barn at north exit of WARNACH. They have been hiding there since the 24th Dec. One PW said that he had desired to give himself up, and the other said they he had hoped for a chance to make his way back to the German lines.

Although in a parachute regiment neither PW has ever had jump training nor have they made any tactical jumps. Both had been in AA units until two months ago, one in Russia and the other in Holland. At the time they were transferred to the Frcht unit thousands of other young men were also transferred. The regiment came from DUISBERG to NIEDERSTEDE on 12 Dec by train. They left here on foot on 15 Dec with the mission of securing a bridge at GOEBELSMUEHL, which they did meeting no resistance. They continued west by foot cross country marching about 30 to 40 Km every night. Each night there were minor skirmishes, And at one place 4 of our tanks delayed their advance for a day, but at night they bypassed them. 4 Km SW of WILTZ they had a battle which netted the Germans about 120 prisoners and 50 assorted vehicles: only the 2nd Bn of the Frcht Regt was engaged here. This incident occurred on the 21st or 22nd Dec. The Germans suffered moderate losses, the 8th Co losing 5 killed, and the rifle companies probably more. The vehicles were distributed throughout the 2nd Bn, the only change in identification being that the star was covered with mud. From uniforms found in the trucks the Germans were issued new shoes, raincoats, underwear, etc. On 23 Dec the cars were sent back to regt. The 2nd Bn proceeded to WARNACH and STRAINCHAMPS with the purpose of severing the BASTAGNE road. The Bn CP was in WARNACH. PW knows that the other two battalions are in this general vicinity but does not know where. The 16th Frcht regiment is to the north of the 15th Regt. At 0200, 24 Dec there were at WARNACH the AA platoon (20mm) without AA guns which had been abandoned because of faulty mounts, and two HMG platoons of the 8th Co, and a MG platoon of the 7th Co. There were also 15 men of 8th Co HQ armed with 4 large bazookas. The mortar platoon of the 8th Co is believed to have gone to TINTANGE. Our troops attacked at this time with tanks, achieving complete surprise and scattered the enemy.

CO of 8th Co is Lt Gebhard. CO of 2nd Bn is Capt Kitze. CO of Regt is Col Groeschke. CO of Div is Col Heilmann.

PW were given 3 days iron rations on 15 Dec. Since using these they have been living "off the land". PW do not know about their general mission nor are they aware of recent German successes. Communication with adjacent units was only by bicycle -- no radio.

STRENGTH : CO consists of 2 pltns, 2 110mm Mort, 12 guns co. guns of 1 pltn were destroyed. CO has approx 50 men, 1 HV/med. CO had 4 COs, location of others unknown, strength same as 1 Co. 50 rds amr carried on P/T with CO gun. Foodline supply adequate.

MOTIONS : CO was attached unknown unit of 5 para Div, to hold present posns. Maximum effective range of gun 1000 yds.

8. 26 Div Div, 30 Div : PV states :

DISPOSITION : 1 Div via KAMLAHAN, location 1 and 2 COs unknown, and 3rd rpd on left flanks of 1 Div. 14 CO via KAMLAHAN.

STRENGTH : 3 CO approx 50 men 3 days ago, now approx 50 men. 3rd CO 3 COs approx 50 men as of 10 Dec. 4 CO approx 150 men/50 men 120, 3 HV AD, 4 100mm (large barbed). Location bkn. 12 CO 3 pltn 50 men/pltn, 10 barbed (large barbed)/pltn, no ven.

MOTIONS : 1 Div to hold present position. PV has no current location with 1 and 2 COs for last 3 days. 14 CO was to join the 2nd Div.

9. 26 Div Div, 77 Div : PV states :

DISPOSITION : 3 CO via KAMLAHAN, 14 CO via KAMLAHAN.

STRENGTH : 3 CO approx 100 men, 1 HV/med, 3 pltns; 14 CO approx 100 men, originally present strength unknown, 3 pltns, 12 barbed (large barbed) and 3 HV/med.

10. 11 Para ADL Div Div, 5 Div : PV states :

DISPOSITION : via KAMLAHAN.

STRENGTH : may supposed to have 7-8 100mm Anti guns, but only 3 very functional, 1 of which fell out because of water trouble. In gun

accompanied by 4-6 inf escorts who dismount when en is contacted. Inf escorts of this btry stand fr 14 Para Regt, 11 Co, altogether 30 men.
MISSION : Asslt guns employed as AT wps, inf escorts to fight short-range AT wps.

11. 245 Asslt Gun Bde, 1st Btry : PW stated :

LOCATION : Btry vic KOMPI, firing btrys probably same vic.
COMBINATION : Bde consists of 3 firing btrys, 3 75mm Asslt Guns and 3 105mm Asslt guns on HAWK III chassis ea. 5 guns at present in repn because damaged en route when struck by our air craft. Bde came from 1 US Army sector vic GAZI, TURKEY to this area approx 2 days ago. PW stated that gasoline supply was inadequate while bde was en route, but has improved since bde was committed.
MISSION : Guns employed for AG defense.

12. 18 mtr (rocket proj) Bde, 22 Regt, 1 Btry : PW stated :

LOCATION : UNKNOWN.
COMBINATION : Bde consists of 21 and 22 Regts, 5 bnd/regt, 5 firing btrys/bn. In 22 Regt 1st Bn has 6 150m ~~WIKI WIKI~~ (rocket proj) firing btrys/bn. In 22 Regt 1st Bn has 6 150m ~~WIKI WIKI~~ (rocket proj) 2 m has 6 210m ~~WIKI WIKI~~ (rocket proj), and 5 bn has 6 300m ~~WIKI WIKI~~ (rocket proj) in each btry. On 21 Regt probably the same.
