

TACTICAL INTERROGATION REPORT
IPW TEAM 60-B, 134TH INFANTRY

11 Sept 44

The two PW, who are medics, advanced towards the fort entrance to take care of a wounded comrade. They were motioned over to our line by American soldiers and taken prisoner.

PW state that at 0600 this morning, 1 Prcht and 4 Inf companies came across the wrecked railroad bridge at 797020 in single file, unmolested by arty fire. The paratroopers belong to the independent Sauttern Battalion which lay in the hills in vicinity 7806, and the infantry units of the ^{553th}~~555th~~ Inf Div are lying in the woods at 7905.

The ^{553th}~~555th~~ Inf Div is a newly formed division which arrived from Germany eight days ago.

PW did not see German tanks, although they have been promised 75 tanks for some time. Most of the German transport here is horsedrawn.

Some of the infantry companies crossing the bridge this morning were the 5th, 6th, 8th Cos.
