

INTERROGATION REPORT

3 PW from 6th Coll 130 Regt, 560 Volksgrenadier Div.

The division consists of the 1128, 1129, and 1130 Regts. Because of heavy losses these are now thrown together and are operating as one battalion with a strength of about 150 men.

PW were sent out as rear guards to outpost OBERBESSLINGEN two days ago. They were sent from HILDANGE where the CP of the Bn was located at that time. Their mission was to await the approach of the Americans and slowly withdraw toward HILDANGE. The weapons of the 26 men included one mg and the rest rifles; they were divided into four squads under the command of a Lt who had his Hq in OBERBESSLINGEN.

All PW were formerly members of the Luftwaffe. They were transferred to the infantry about 1st Nov 44. PW arrived here as replacements three days ago at which time a total of 8 replacements came forward. The division had already been badly chewed up at the time they arrived and PW do not know where it had suffered its heavy losses.

Between HILDANGE and GREIFLINGEN PW saw 7 or 8 tanks going in an easterly direction. They also saw some which were snow-bound in the vicinity of PURG REULAND. Two days ago they saw 4 assault guns in HILDANGE.
